STATEMENT OF FAITH

CALVARY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

(A Ministry Of Calvary Baptist Church)

1. We believe in the verbal inspiration and the authority of the Scriptures. We believe that the Bible reveals God, the fall of man, the way of salvation, and God's plan and purpose in the ages. The Bible is the final authority in all matters of faith and practice.
2. We believe there is one God, eternally existent, Creator of the heaven and the earth, and manifested in three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit, equal in all respects.
3. We believe in the deity of Jesus Christ, who was virgin born, manifested in the flesh, lived a sinlessly perfect life, died for the sins of the world, was buried, arose bodily from the grave on the third day, ascended to heaven, and whose return is imminent. In His death, burial and resurrection He paid in full the wages of sin (past, present, and future) for all who believe on Him.
4. We believe that man was created (not evolved) in God's image, but sinned, is now totally depraved, and in need of salvation.
5. We believe that salvation is "by grace" through faith in Jesus Christ, plus nothing and minus nothing. Human merit plays no part in salvation, which requires only repentance toward God and faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ on the cross where He atoned for the sins of mankind. Because it is given wholly by God's grace, the believer's salvation is eternally secure in Jesus Christ.
6. We believe in the imminent, personal and visible return of Jesus Christ for His church prior to the Tribulation period and His return to set up His kingdom after the Tribulation, after which the saved will be forever with the Lord, and the lost will be confined for eternity in the lake of fire.
7. We believe in the everlasting conscious blessedness of the saved and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost.
8. We believe that Satan is a person, the arch enemy of God and God's people.
9. We believe that God gives spiritual gifts to all believers for the building up of local New Testament churches. Some gifts of the Spirit, however, were given as miraculous signs to unbelievers before the completion of the New Testament, and have since diminished or ceased.
10. We believe that believers are called to a life of separation from all worldly and sinful practices and alliances.
11. We believe that the local church is composed only of believers, baptized by immersion, organized, observing the two ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper. We believe that the church is God's plan for reaching the world with the Gospel in compliance with the Great Commission, and that every Christian should be actively involved in the ministry of a Bible-believing, soul-winning, New Testament church.
12. We believe that civil government is of Divine appointment for the interests and good of human society. Magistrates are to be prayed for, conscientiously honored and obeyed except in things opposed to the will of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who is the only Lord of the kings of the earth.
13. We believe that children belong to the Lord, are entrusted to the care of parents who are expected to "train them up in the way they should go," who in turn secure the help of others (the Christian school) in accomplishing this task every moment of every day. Only the home and the church are commissioned by God to educate His children.
14. We believe that the only legitimate marriage is the joining of one man and one woman. (Gen. 2:24; Rom. 7:2; 1 Cor. 7:10; Eph. 5:22-23) We believe that any forms of bodily contact for the purpose of satisfying sexual desires between anyone other than one man and one woman in marriage are immoral, are forbidden by God and are sinful perversions of God's gift of sex. Further, we believe that God disapproves of as immoral and forbids any attempt to alter one's gender by surgery or appearance. (Gen. 2:24; Gen. 19:5, 13; Gen. 26:8-9; Lev. 18:1-30; Rom. 1: 26-29; 1 Cor. 5:1; 6:9; 1 Thess. 4:1-8; Heb. 13:4)

See the CCS Parent/Student Handbook and the Calvary Baptist Church By Laws, Section III for an expansion of this Statement of Faith with a listing of Scripture references from which these truths are learned. The Church and School are inseparable in doctrine.

The purpose of CCS is not only to teach academics, but also, and more importantly, to teach the Truth of God's Word, to provide an environment where young people can receive that Truth, and to teach them how to apply that Truth wisely to their lives.

CCS is a direct extension of the Christian home and church. To function Scripturally CCS must provide a continuity of training for Christian young people. Therefore CCS teachers, textbooks, extracurricular activities, rules and enforcement, enrollment policies, etc. must be true to principles taught in God's Word (the Bible).

The CCS faculty work hard to obey God's command to ... "Train up a child in the way he should go ... " and ... "bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord." (Pro. 22:6, Eph. 6:4) Students are taught often and in many ways to give careful attention to God's instructions ... "Cease my son to hear the instruction that causeth thee to err from the words of knowledge," and ... "learn not the way of the heathen." (Pro. 19:27, Jer. 10:2)

Through both direct teaching and controlling influences at school, CCS students are continually taught that ... "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge." (Pro. 1:7)

- _____ 1. This application/agreement is to be considered a binding contract with CCS. If accepted, we will follow the rules of the school.
- _____ 2. We understand that faithful, weekly church attendance and membership is strongly encouraged. (required in junior and senior high grades)
- _____ 3. We understand that CCS will administer a complete education to our child in all areas (spiritual, academic, physical, social) as directed by God's Word.
- _____ 4. We understand that doctrine, principles of life, standards of behavior, etc. will be taught from Scriptures as held by fundamental Baptist churches throughout history, and as taught by Calvary Baptist Church.
- _____ 5. We accept responsibility for our child's attitude toward and willingness to obey all persons in authority at CCS. We will work cooperatively with the teacher in solving attitude and behavior problems.
- _____ 6. If all usual school and home disciplinary measures fail, I will make myself available to come to school during the day to administer discipline to my child.

- _____ 7. We understand that our child will not be allowed to remain a student of CCS if he/she shows continued ...
 1) aggression toward other students, 2) disobedience, 3) disrespect, 4) offensive language or actions, 5) disruptive behavior, 6) disrespect for the spiritual values of CCS, etc.
- _____ 8. We recognize and accept our responsibility to guard our children against the influence of any shows, movies, videos, etc. that promote profane or immoral activities or language, or excessively violent behavior.
- _____ 9. We understand that CCS cannot change policies, procedures, curriculum, etc. to accommodate the special needs or desires of a few.
- _____ 10. We pledge to carefully control matters of school attendance. Our child will be faithfully present and on time each day, unless providentially hindered. (Limit = 20 days per year in elementary grades)
- _____ 11. **We will pay all financial obligations on or before the due date** (tuition, fees, late stay, etc). We understand ... 1) that unpaid accounts become delinquent on the 1st business day after the 10th of each month, 2) that a \$10 late charge is imposed for each delinquent month, 3) that if an account becomes 60 days past due our child(ren) will not be allowed to attend classes until the account is settled, 4) that at the end of the year no records, report cards, diplomas, or transcripts will be issued until the account is paid in full, and 5) an account with an outstanding balance remaining after a family has withdrawn from CCS will incur a late fee each month equal to 1.5% of the outstanding balance until paid in full. We understand that these policies must be maintained to insure the financial stability of the school, and that a meeting of the school committee can be requested if there are unusual circumstances requiring special arrangements. We understand that only the school committee can approve special arrangements.
- _____ 12. We give permission for our child to take part in activities sponsored by CCS, including field trips, athletic events, etc., away from the school premises. We absolve the school from liability due to any injury to our child at school or during a school activity. We give permission for emergency medical treatment to be administered in event of accident or illness.
- _____ 13. We will carefully support all programs, standards, regulations, and discipline as described in the CCS Parent/Student Handbook or implemented by the school.
- _____ 14. We will **not criticize or gossip** about the school. If a problem concerning a classroom situation or school policy arises, we will always **contact the teacher first**, followed by other school officials as necessary (**not other parents**).

As parents who are responsible to God for our children, we do hereby state that we have made a thorough investigation of CCS. We pledge to make it our glad-hearted choice for the coming school year. We understand and agree to all points of this Parent Agreement. We understand that we are entering into a spiritual, financial and practical commitment. Having first fully and comprehensively read the school handbook, we understand that by signing below we are pledging that ... 1) we will cooperate with the school and are in agreement with the school purpose, philosophy, policies, procedures & regulations, 2) we will pay all fees and tuition according to the schedule described in the "Financial Policies" of the school, and 3) we will bring all concerns to the proper school administration personnel in an intelligent, gracious, and Christ-like manner.
